


"For you are all children of God by faith in Christ Jesus ...

- 1. REPENT Admitting your sinfulness, turn from the way you have lived without God. (Acts 3:19)
- 2. REALISE The only way to be right with God is through the death of His Son, Jesus Christ. He died for your sins. THANK HIM. (I Corinthians 15:3)
- 3. RECEIVE Him into your life to take over and bring new life. (Revelation 3:20)
- 4. REJOICE You have been born again and are now God's child! (John 1:12; Romans 8:16)
 You have eternal life! (John 3:16)
 You can know His power! (Acts 1:8)
 You can serve Him! (Mark 16:15)

If you have come God's Way – fulfilling the conditions above – you have joined His Forever Family! Be warned: as a child of God you are a marked man (or woman) – the powers of darkness under the control of Satan will work to steal your relationship with Jesus away from you.

(I Peter 5:8) But you will be safe from every attack if you stick to the guidance overleaf.

HIS PART

He has said: "I will never leave you or forsake you" (Hebrews 13:5) "no-one shall pluck them out of my hand" (John 10:28)

YOUR PART

- Keep a special time before breakfast (not easy, but vital!) to:
 IALK TO JESUS. LET JESUS TALK TO YOU. And talk to Him during the day.
- Remember there may be times when Jesus doesn't SEEM near that's when you rely on God's Word (The Bible). His PROMISES and LOVE never fail. Find out about His promises and get guidance for everyday living by reading the Bible each day. (Start with Luke and letters of Peter. Then get yourself a reading plan). The more you read the more your faith will grow.
- Being a child of God is a life of looking to JESUS and TRUSTING HIM. Give all your problems and failings over to Him (confession brings cleansing, confiding brings confidence). And don't forget to thank Him when He answers prayer.
- 4. SPIRITUAL JOY is something that only a follower of Jesus experiences and is not dependant on circumstances and emotions.
 Your JOY will grow as you share your faith with other BORN-AGAIN CHRISTIANS. That means praying, worshipping and studying the Bible with His people as often as you can.
- TELL OTHERS ABOUT JESUS Serving the Lord can be exciting! Though you're fearful and weak, God can, and wants to
 express His love for men THROUGH YOU. His command (Mark 16:15) should give us a deep concern to win others to Christ.
